The Creditor and the Issuer entered into a debt conversion agreement (the “**Debt Conversion Agreement**”) on February 20, 2018, pursuant to which the Creditor agreed to accept 30,871,342 Common Shares at a deemed issued price of \$0.005 per Common Share, in full settlement of \$154,356.71 of indebtedness owing to the Creditor by the Issuer (the “**Transaction**”). The Transaction closed on March 14, 2018.

The Creditor is controlled by Richard Patricio.

The Creditor acquired 30,871,342 Common Shares of the Issuer, representing approximately 16.21% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer respectively.

Prior to the closing of the Transaction, Richard Patricio, a joint actor to the Creditor, directly and indirectly, owned and controlled 650,000 Common Shares representing approximately 1.12% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer.

After giving effect to the Transaction, Richard Patricio, in concert with the Creditor, directly and indirectly, owns and controls 31,521,342 Common Shares representing approximately 16.55% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer.

The Creditor received 30,871,342 Common Shares through the settlement of an aggregate of \$154,356.71 of indebtedness at a price of \$0.005 per Common Share.

The Creditor acquired 30,871,342 Common Shares of the Issuer at a price of \$0.005 per Common Share pursuant to a Debt Conversion Agreement for aggregate cash consideration of \$154,356.71.

The 30,871,342 Common Shares were acquired through the settlement of an aggregate of \$154,356.71 of indebtedness owed to the Creditor.

The securities were acquired for investment purposes. The Creditor has a long-term view of the investment and may, depending on market and other conditions, or as future circumstances may dictate, from time to time, on an individual or joint basis, increase or dispose of some or all of the existing or additional securities he holds or will hold, or may continue to hold her current position. The Creditor currently has no other plans or intentions that relate to, or would result in the matters listed in clauses (a) to (j), above. Depending on market conditions, general economic and industry conditions, the Issuer's business and financial condition and/or other relevant factors, the Creditor may develop such plans or intentions in the future.

Pursuant to the terms of the Debt Conversion Agreement the Creditor agreed to accept 30,871,342 Common Shares at a deemed issued price of \$0.005 per Common Share, in full settlement of \$154,356.71 of indebtedness owing to the Creditor by the Issuer. The Transaction closed on March 14, 2018.
