In accordance with section 4.11 of National Instrument 51-102 *Continuous Disclosure Obligations* ("**NI51-102**") the Audit Committee and the Board of Directors of The BC Bud Corporation ("**the Company**"), hereby provide notices that Smythe LLP has resigned as the Company's auditor effective August 5, 2022.

In accordance with NI 51-102, we confirm that:

- (a) Smythe has resigned on its own initiative effective as at August 5, 2022;
- (b) Smythe has not expressed any reservation in its reports for the two most recently completed fiscal years of the Company, nor for the period from the most recently completed period for which Smythe issued an audit report in respect of the Company and the date of this notice;
- (c) This notice and the resignation of Smythe as the auditor of the Company was considered and approved by the audit committee and the board of directors of the Company. The audit committee and the board of directors of the Company is actively considering options for a new auditor but have not yet recommended a replacement auditor to fill the vacancy; and
- (d) In the opinion of the board of directors of the Company no reportable events (as defined in section 7(e) of NI 51-102) has occurred in connection with the audits of the two most recently completed fiscal years of the Company, nor any period from the most recently completed period for which Smythe issued an audit report in respect of the Company and the date of this notice.
