On June 25, 2018, the Company issued 344,005 Common Shares to the Acquiror pursuant to the completion of the Debt Settlement.

On June 25, 2018, the Company issued 344,005 Common Shares to the Acquiror pursuant to the completion of the Debt Settlement.

Steven Mintz of Toronto, Ontario, acquired 344,005 Common Shares. Mr. Mintz, together with Heather Mintz, the spouse of Mr. Mintz, now owns an aggregate of 1,532,015 Common Shares and common share purchase warrant (“**Warrants**”) exercisable for the purchase of 500,000 Common Shares, representing 15.67% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares on a non-diluted basis, and 19.77% on a partially-diluted basis (assuming exercise of Mr. Mintz’s convertible securities).

3.2 State whether the acquiror acquired or disposed ownership of, or acquired or ceased to have control over, the securities that triggered the requirement to file this report.

The Acquiror acquired ownership of or control over 344,005 Common Shares.

Prior to the Debt Settlement, the Acquiror held 500,000 Common Shares and 500,000 Warrants (12.30% of the outstanding shares of the Issuer on an undiluted basis and 21.90% on a partially diluted basis). Following the Debt Settlement, Mr. Mintz, together with Heather Mintz, the spouse of Mr. Mintz, now owns an aggregate of 1,532,015 Common Shares and Warrants exercisable for the purchase of 500,000 Common Shares, representing 15.67% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares on a non-diluted basis, and 19.77% on a partially-diluted basis (assuming exercise of Mr. Mintz’s convertible securities).
