Management's Discussion & Analysis
Three and Six Months Ended October 31, 2012 and 2011

The following Management's Discussion & Analysis ("MD&A") as provided by the management of Top Strike Resources Corp., formerly "Colossal Resources Corp." ("Top Strike" or the "Company") should be read in conjunction with the Company's unaudited condensed interim financial statements and accompanying notes for the three and six months ended October 31, 2012 and 2011 and the audited financial statements and accompanying notes for the years ended April 30, 2012 and 2011. All financial measures are expressed in Canadian dollars unless otherwise indicated. Top Strike's MD&A and financial statements were prepared under International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS"). The reader should be aware that historical results are not necessarily indicative of future performance. The effective date of this MD&A is December 18, 2012.

Management is responsible for the preparation and integrity of the financial statements, including the maintenance of appropriate information systems, procedures and internal controls and to ensure that information used internally or disclosed externally, including the financial statements and MD&A, is complete and reliable. The Company's board of directors follows recommended corporate governance guidelines for public companies to ensure transparency and accountability to shareholders. The board's audit committee meets with management on a quarterly basis to review the financial statements including the MD&A and to discuss other financial, operating and internal control matters.

Statements in this report that are not historical facts are forward-looking statements involving known and unknown risks and uncertainties, which could cause actual results to vary considerably from these statements. DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS AND OVERVIEW

The Company is in the business of acquiring, exploring and developing petroleum and natural gas properties and currently has no resource developing activity and is considered to be in the development stage.

The common shares of the Company are listed on the NEX board of the TSX Venture Exchange. Effective December 13, 2012, the Company changed its name from "Colossal Resources Corp." to "Top Strike Resources Corp." and currently trades under the symbol "TSR.H".

The Company has evaluated several oil and gas opportunities, but has yet to reach the point where the Company can enter into a letter of intent of any kind. The Company is focused on international oil and gas projects but also considers domestic oil and gas opportunities.

Management will continue to seek projects, primarily in the oil and gas sector, that will provide the best opportunities to increase shareholders value.

RESULTS OF OPERATIONS

Financial results

Overall, the Company recorded a net loss of \$32,403 (\$0.00 loss per share) for the six months ended October 31, 2012 as compared to a net loss of \$37,146 (\$0.00 loss per share) for the six months ended October 31, 2011.

The Company had no operating revenue for the six months ended October 31, 2012 and 2011. The net loss is comprised of general and administrative expenses of \$32,403 (2011 - \$37,146).

Significant expenses during the six months ended October 31, 2012 were consulting fees of \$7,093 (2011 - \$3,750), professional fees of \$17,739 (primarily legal of \$22,119 less an over accrual for the 2012 year end audit and accounting) (2011 - \$23,222) and transfer agent, listing and filing fees of \$7,080 (2011 - \$10,044). General and administrative expenses remain low as there was minimal corporate activity during the period. Consulting fees include \$2,093 incurred to evaluate some domestic oil and gas production.

LIQUIDITY, FINANCINGS AND CAPITAL RESOURCES

At October 31, 2012, the Company had a cash balance of \$8,695 (April 30, 2012 - \$316) to settle current liabilities of \$171,417 (April 30, 2012 - \$127,287). The Company expects to fund these liabilities through the issuance of capital stock and loans over the coming year.

As at October 31, 2012, the Company's cash increased by \$8,379 to \$8,695 from \$316 as at April 30, 2012, which is the net cash provided by loans payable (financing activity) of \$27,460 less net cash used for operating activities of \$18,661 and acquisition of accounting software of \$420.

On December 14, the Company completed a non-brokered private placement of 4,273,666 units ("Units") at a price of \$0.12 per Unit for gross proceeds of \$512,840. Each Unit is comprised of one common share and one half of one common share purchase warrant with each whole warrant entitling the holder to acquire one common share at a price of \$0.20 for a period of 12 months from the date of issuance.

Loans payable

As at October 31, 2012, loans payable were \$59,046 (April 30, 2012 - \$31,586), and are due on demand and non-interest bearing.

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RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

During the six months ended October 31, 2012, the Company paid or accrued consulting fees of \$2,500 (2011 - \$nil) to a company controlled by a director of the Company and paid or accrued legal fees of \$20,750 to a legal firm of which a director of the Company is a partner. These amounts are billed and recorded at rates consistent with those charged to third parties.

As at October 31, 2012, accounts payable and accrued liabilities included amounts payable to related parties totaling \$22,150 (2011 - \$nil) for consulting fees, including HST.

The Company borrowed \$4,560 (2011 - \$nil) from an officer and director of the Company. The amount is due on demand and is non-interest bearing.

As at October 31, 2012, loans payable included amounts payable to related parties totaling \$4,560 (2011 - \$nil).

CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

The Company has no commitments for property and equipment expenditures for fiscal 2013. The Company anticipates that any property and equipment expenditures based on future needs, will be funded from the issuance of equity securities.

OFF-SHEET BALANCE ARRANGEMENTS

The Company has not entered into any off-balance sheet arrangements.

PROPOSED TRANSACTIONS

As at the date of this MD&A, there are no proposed transactions that the board of directors or senior management have decided to proceed with and that have not been publicly disclosed.

RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

The Company's financial success will be dependent upon the Company's ability to raise equity. There is no assurance that the Company will be able to raise the equity required to meet the obligations of the Company and the Company has no source of financing other than those identified in the previous section.

Going Concern

To date, the Company has not generated any significant revenues and is considered to be in the development stage. The Company has a history of negative cash flows from operations and as of October 31, 2012 has an accumulated deficit of \$17,440,024. The Company continues to be dependent upon its ability to finance its operations and any acquisitions of exploration and evaluation properties through financing activities that may include issuances of additional debt or equity securities.
