



Glenbriar shareholders approve sale of IT services business

CALGARY, AB, **December 4, 2017** — **Glenbriar Technologies Inc.** (CSE: GTI) today announced its shareholders approved the previously announced sale of its information technology services business to Uniserve Communications Corporation (TSX-V: USS) at the Special Meeting of Shareholders held earlier today by a margin of over 99%. The required 2/3 majority was easily achieved for both the overall vote and for the minority shareholders voting as a separate class. No shareholders exercised dissent rights.

Details of the transaction are set forth in the Information Circular for the Special Meeting, which is posted on Sedar and on Glenbriar's website.
