GENIUS COMPLETES FIRST PAYMENT OF THE DISSIMIEUX ACQUISITION

April 6, 2016- Montréal, Québec – Genius Properties Ltd. (the "**Corporation**") (CSE: GNI) is pleased to announce it has issued 6,000,000 common shares of the Corporation (each a "Share") to Jourdan Resources Inc. pursuant to its previously announced acquisition of the Dissimieux Lake Phosphate Titanium-REE's property.
