On October 17, 2017, the Acquiror acquired ownership of 2,650,000 common shares and 2,700,000 warrants of Quinsam pursuant to a share exchange agreement ("**Share Exchange Agreement**") between Quinsam, High Standard Royalty Corp. ("**High Standard**") and existing shareholders of High Standard (collectively referred to as the "**Vendors**").

As a result of the acquisition, FMICAI has ownership, control and direction over of approximately 10.97% of the issued and outstanding common shares of Quinsam on a partially diluted basis.

On October 17, 2017, and as a result of the Transaction, the Acquiror acquired ownership over

an aggregate of 2,650,000 common shares and 2,700,000 warrants of Quinsam. After the acquisition of common shares and warrants, FMICAI now has ownership of 2,650,000 common shares and 2,700,000 warrants of the Issuer, representing approximately 10.97% of the issued and outstanding common shares of Quinsam on a partially diluted basis.

Prior to the acquisition of Quinsam common shares and warrants by FMICAI on October 17, 2017, FMICAI held nil common shares and nil warrants of Quinsam.

3.2 State whether the acquiror acquired or disposed ownership of, or acquired or ceased to have control over, the securities that triggered the requirement to file this report.

The Acquiror acquired ownership of an aggregate of 2,650,000 common shares and 2,700,000 warrants of the Issuer, resulting in ownership by FMICAI of approximately 10.97% of the issued and outstanding shares of the Issuer.

Immediately after the Transaction that triggered the requirement to file this report, the Acquiror owned an aggregate of 2,650,000 common shares and 2,700,000 warrants of Quinsam, representing approximately 10.97% of the Issuer's issued and outstanding common shares.

Immediately following the Transaction that triggered the requirement to file this report, the Acquiror has ownership, alone, over an aggregate of 2,650,000 common Shares and 2,700,000 warrants of the Issuer, representing approximately 10.97% of the issued and outstanding common shares of the Issuer.

On October 17, 2017, the Acquiror acquired 2,650,000 common shares and 2,700,000 warrants of the Issuer in exchange for common shares and warrants of High Standard pursuant to the Transaction.

Except as described herein, while the Acquiror has no current plans or intentions that relate to or would result in the items listed in (a) through (k) above, depending on various factors including, without limitation, the Issuer's financial position, the price levels of the common shares of the Issuer, conditions in the securities markets and general economic and industry conditions, the Issuer's business or financial condition, and other factors and conditions the Acquiror deems appropriate, the Acquiror may acquire additional securities in the future but has no current plans or future intentions to do so.
