Item 4: Summary of Material Change

In April of 2013, the Company announced that it had won an appeal before the United States Court of Appeals, Fifth Circuit following the successful defense of a lawsuit where a judgment was entered in February of 2012 in favor of the Company and all of the other named defendants by the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division.

On June 26, 2013 the Company announced that a subsequent petition filed by the Plaintiff to rehear the appeal has also been denied, thus affirming the underlying judgment dismissing all claims against the named defendants. The Company has now been advised by counsel that the subject litigation has been concluded.

Item 5: Full Description of Material Change

The lawsuit was originally filed in February, 2010, prior to the current management joining the Company, and initially sought \$1,000,000,000 in monetary damages against 16 defendants, including the Company. The plaintiff alleged causes of action for misuse of its confidential information in the locating and staking of mining claims.

In February, 2012, a judgment was entered in favor of the Company and all of the other named Defendants by the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division.

Following the judgment in favor of the Company in February, 2012, an appeal was filed and an appeal hearing was held in December, 2012. On April 17, 2013, the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit issued its opinion affirming the judgment in the court below in favor of all defendants.

A subsequent petition filed by the Plaintiff to rehear the appeal has also been denied, thus affirming the underlying judgment dismissing all claims against the named defendants. The Company has now been advised by counsel that the subject litigation has been concluded.
