On February 16, 2022, the Issuer issued 30,465,690 SVS upon the amendment and conversion of secured convertible debentures of the Issuer and issued 32,710,087 SVS upon the conversion of accrued payables of the Issuer, in each case at a deemed issuance price of \$0.06 per SVS (the "Transaction").

Pursuant to the Transaction, the Acquiror acquired 4,214,954 SVS upon the amendment and conversion of secured convertible debentures of the Issuer held by the Acquiror and 7,731,083 SVS pursuant to the settlement of payables owed from the Issuer to the Acquiror (collectively, the "Acquisition").

7,731,083 SVS acquired by the Acquiror pursuant to the Acquisition were acquired by 2674775 Ontario Limited, a company in which Adam Szweras is the majority shareholder.
