If the acquiror exercises all the Warrants, the acquiror would beneficially own 150,253,422 Common Shares of the Issuer, which would represent approximately 45.4743% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer on a fully diluted basis.

The acquiror, alone, owns and controls a total of 119,197,521 Common Shares of the Issuer representing approximately 39.8178% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer, and owns and controls 31,055,901 Warrants, which if the acquiror exercises all the Warrants, the acquiror would beneficially own 150,253,422 Common Shares of the Issuer, which would represent approximately 45.47% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer on a fully diluted basis.

The joint actor 12544 concurrently acquired alone, owns and controls 76,986,776 Common Shares of the Issuer representing approximately 25.7173% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer, and owns and control 10,000,000 Warrants, which if the joint actor exercises all the Warrants, the joint actor would beneficially own 86,986,776 Common Shares of the Issuer, which would represent approximately 26.3266% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer on a fully diluted basis.

The joint actor 5822 concurrently alone, owns and controls 42,210,745 Common Shares of the Issuer representing approximately 14.1004% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer, and owns and controls 21,055,900 Warrants, which if the joint actor exercises all the Warrants, the joint actor would beneficially own 63,266,646 Common Shares of the Issuer, which would represent approximately 21.1341% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer on a fully diluted basis.

The joint actors, 12544 and 5822, together own and control 119,197,521 Common Shares of the Issuer representing approximately 39.8178% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer. Together the acquiror and the joint actors own a total of 238,395,042 Common Shares of the Issuer representing together approximately 79.6355% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer, and the acquiror and the joint actors own 62,111,801 Common Share warrants, which if the acquiror and the joint actors exercise all the Common Share warrants, the acquiror and the joint actors would beneficially own 300,506,843 Common Shares of the Issuer, which would represent approximately 83.1347% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer on a fully diluted basis
