WESTRIDGE RETAINS ACQUA CAPITAL GROUP

Vancouver, British Columbia CANADA - Westridge Resources Inc. (“Westridge” or the “Company”) is pleased to announce that it has entered into a service agreement with Acqua Capital Group (“ACG”) to provide investor relations services to the Company over 12-month renewable term, subject to TSX Venture Exchange (the “Exchange”) approval. ACG, founded by its principal, John Bevilacqua, will provide assistance with the Company’s investor relations and public relations efforts. ACG and John Bevilacqua are at arm’s length to the Company.

ACG is a Vancouver-based premier investor relations consulting firm specializing in resource and technology companies. ACG will provide investor relations and marketing services for the Company including, but not limited to, Company information dissemination to the public and Westridge’s shareholders, inquiry response, assistance with Company events and advertising. The Company expects the services of ACG will increase its exposure to institutional and retail investors throughout North America and Europe.

Under the renewable agreement, ACG will receive a fee of \$5,000 per month plus HST plus approved expenses. In addition, ACG will receive 150,000 incentive stock options (the “Options”) to purchase common shares in the capital of the Company (the “Shares”), exercisable at a price of \$0.60 per Share up to and including the earlier of the date which is five years from the date of the grant of the Options or the 30th day after ACG ceases to provide services to the Company. The Options will vest in stages over 12 month period with ¼ of the options vesting in every three month period.

The renewable agreement may be terminated by either party by providing 30-day written notice to the other party of such termination.
