

ME RESOURCE CORP. ANNOUNCES JV WITH ABS ELECTRIC GROUP LTD. TO FORM WASTE STREAM ENERGY CORP.

September 30, 2013, VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA – ME Resource Corp. (the "Company" or "MEC") (CNSX: MEC | OTC: MEEXF) is pleased to announce that it has entered into a joint venture partnership (the "JV") with ABS Electric Group Ltd. ("ABS"). ABS is a fully integrated power generation and electrical company in the Alberta Oil and Gas industry, which maintains and constructs electrical and power systems from Millivolt to High Voltage applications. ABS has 12 years of experience within the Alberta oil patch, employs 80 people with over 40 field-service vehicles and a 40,000 square foot fabrication and manufacturing facility.

The JV has established a new company, Waste Stream Energy Corp. ("WSE"), which will be granted a license (the "License") for MEC's Micro-Refinery Unit ("MRU") for the territory of Canada. As per the terms of the JV and the License, WSE will facilitate the development and commercialization of the MRU.

In addition to the License MEC will contribute financial and technical expertise to the project. ABS will make available a dedicated staff, its full service and maintenance field teams, fabrication facilities and in-kind contributions to the JV to further this development. ABS's existing clientele, which include Kinder Morgan, Pennwest and SNC Lavalin, as well as their valuable relationships with individual site superintendents, can be leveraged to assist in the development, commercialization and the eventual operation of the MRU.

President of ABS, Dave Comer, stated, "We are very excited about this new joint venture and the licensed technology. Having our boots on the ground in the oil patch we have an acute understanding of the needs of the industry. We are confident that the micro-refinery unit can address power and fuel needs while creating revenue streams, as well as providing a solution that reduces emissions of harmful green house gases. It's really a win-win situation for the operator and the environment".

The JV structure provides MEC a 60% equity interest in WSE, while ABS has a 40% interest. The JV also includes provisions which would allow for a MEC buyback of ABS's interest in the JV.

President of MEC, Navchand Jagpal spoke to the merits of the joint venture by saying, "Waste Stream Energy Corp. will give MEC's Micro-Refinery Unit a presence in a very significant region in the oil and gas industry, Alberta, as well as Canada. Waste Stream will allow for expansion into power generation, servicing and maintenance. MEC's management sees significant shareholder value in this joint venture".
