Option Three participated in the Company's last private placement and purchased 19.83% of BacTech in October 2012. As part of its subscription, Option Three and the Company entered into an Exclusivity Agreement pursuant to which, among other things, Option Three is entitled, subject to applicable law, to nominate a member to the Board of

Directors of BacTech for so long as it directly or indirectly holds at least 10% of the issued and outstanding common shares of BacTech.

The Company also announced that its Environmental Act Proposal had been posted for public comment by the Environmental Approvals Branch of the Manitoba Department of Conservation and Water Stewardship.
