## ACANA CAPITAL CORP. COMPLETES SHARE CONSOLIDATION

The Company obtained approval from the Canadian National Stock Exchange on May 9, 2012 and is completing the necessary corporate filings in order to effect the Consolidation.

Currently, a total of 75,466,702 common shares in the capital of the Company are issued and outstanding. On a ten (10) old for one (1) new basis (the "Consolidation Ratio") a total of approximately 7,546,670 common shares of the Company will be issued and outstanding following the Consolidation. The exact number of post consolidation shares will vary depending on the treatment of fractional shares which will occur when each shareholder's holdings in the Company are consolidated. Any fractional share remaining after giving effect to the consolidation that is less than one-half of one share shall be deemed to be cancelled and each fractional share that is at least one-half of one share shall be deemed to be changed to one whole share. Outstanding stock options and warrants will be similarly adjusted by the Consolidation Ratio.

At the opening of trading on May 14th, 2012, the shares will trade under a new CUSIP number. The stock symbol will remain the same.

Details of the Consolidation are contained in the Company's Information Circular mailed to shareholders on March 15th, 2012.
