General

This Management Discussion and Analysis ("MD&A") has been prepared by management as of January 27, 2014 of the financial position of the Company and results of operations for the year ended September 30, 2014 and should be read in conjunction with the financial statements of Railtown Capital Corp. Liquidity and Capital Resources

As at September 30, 2014, the Company's working capital deficiency increased to \$21,891 (September 30, 2013 – \$3,485) as a result of unpaid professional fees. As at September 30, 2014, the Company had cash on hand of \$33,222 (September 30, 2013 - \$39,801).

Results of Operations for the nine months ended June 30, 2014

During the year ended September 30, 2014, the Company was inactive, save for its continued evaluation of potential acquisition targets, and as a result the Company recorded a loss of \$28,406 (2013 - \$19,995) and a loss per share of \$nil (2013 - \$nil).

The loss for the year was primarily due to filing fees of 7,771 (2013 - 5,177) paid to the transfer agent and professional fees of 9,450 (2013 - 14,663) paid for accounting services. The increase over the prior period is due to increased costs related to professional fees.

Results of Operations for the three months ended June 30, 2014

During the three months ended June 30, 2014, the Company was inactive, save for its continued evaluation of potential acquisition targets, and as a result the Company recorded a loss of \$11,089 (2013 - \$34) and a loss per share of \$nil (2013 - \$nil).

The loss for the three month period was primarily due to professional fees of \$9,955 (2013 - \$nil) paid for accounting services.
