On March 27, 2020, the Acquiror acquired 1,250,000 Units for gross proceeds of CAD\$100,000 as part of a non-brokered private placement of the Issuer. Each Unit consists of (i) one common share in the capital of the Issuer (each, a “**Common Share**”), and (ii) one half of a common share purchase warrant (each full warrant, a “**Warrant**”), with each full Warrant entitling the holder to subscribe for one additional Common Share at an exercise price of CAD \$0.12 per share at any time prior to the day that is 24 months from the grant of the Warrant

Prior to the Private Placement, the Acquiror owned or controlled 10,000,000 Common Shares, and Warrants to purchase 1,250,000 Common Shares. The Acquiror owned or controlled 19.2 % of the issued and outstanding Common Shares prior to the Private Placement and 21.1 % assuming conversion or exercise of all securities owned or controlled by the Acquiror.

Following the Private placement, the Acquiror owns or controls 11,250,000 Common Shares and Warrants to purchase 1,875,000 Common Shares. Following the Private Placement, the Acquiror owns or controls 14.2 % of the issued and outstanding Common Shares and 16.2 % assuming conversion or exercise of all securities owned or controlled by the Acquiror.
