On April 7, 2022, the Issuer completed a private placement consisting of a total of 6,154,615 Common Shares at a price of \$0.065 per share for gross proceeds of \$400,050 pursuant to which Mr. Steinepreis, through Croesus Mining Pty Ltd., acquired 769,231 Common Shares (the "**Transaction**").

The 769,231 Common Shares acquired by Mr. Steinepreis represent approximately 2.76% of the current issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer.

Prior to the Transaction, Mr. Steinepreis held 3,538,076 Common Shares representing approximately 16.28% of the Issuer's issued and outstanding Common Shares, and stock options to acquire an additional 950,000 Common Shares. If Mr. Steinepreis exercised all of his stock options, he would have held 4,488,076 Common Shares, representing approximately 19.78% of the Issuer's then issued and outstanding Common Shares.

Following the Transaction, Mr. Steinepreis' Common Share ownership in the Issuer decreased to approximately 15.44%, since the effective date of Mr. Steinepreis' last Early Warning Report (January 17, 2022) and after taking into account subsequent issuances of Common Shares by the Issuer since said last report. If Mr. Steinepreis was to exercise all of his stock options, his Common Share ownership would decrease to approximately 18.23%, since the effective date of Mr. Steinepreis' last Early Warning Report (January 17, 2022) and after taking into account subsequent issuances of Common Shares by the Issuer since said last report.

Mr. Steinepreis acquired the Common Shares.

If Mr. Steinepreis exercised all of his stock options, he would have held 4,488,076 Common Shares, representing approximately 19.78% of the Issuer's then issued and outstanding Common Shares.

Immediately after the Transaction, Mr. Steinepreis owns, or exercises control or direction over, 4,307,307 Common Shares, representing approximately 15.44% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer, and stock options to acquire an additional 950,000 Common Shares. If Mr. Steinepreis exercised all of his stock options, he would have held 5,257,307 Common Shares, representing approximately 18.23% of the Issuer's then issued and outstanding Common Shares.
