GLOBAL CANNABIS SECURES EXCLUSIVE RELATIONSHIP WITH LEADING ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE PROVIDER

(“**GCAC Australia**”), the Company’s 61% subsidiary in Australia, has secured an exclusive global license for Medical Cannabis Artificial Intelligence (“**AI**”) regulation technology with Australian-based Compliance Master International (“**CMI**”).

GCAC Australia will hold the exclusive global usage and distribution rights to ‘Cannabis Compliance AI’ – a cutting edge AI risk-based auditing and inspection technology to be rolled out to the global medical cannabis industry.

“We are very excited to be working with GCAC on this venture,” said CMI’s founder and Chief Executive Officer Peter Mills, who is a highly regarded Australian data scientist. “In particular, we see this as an unparalleled opportunity to establish our world-leading technology as the benchmark for managing regulatory risks in Australia and other countries with medical cannabis programs.”

One of the biggest challenges facing governments is establishing the necessary regulatory structures and processes needed to reliably monitor and control quality and supply-chain risks of medical cannabis, while reducing the costs and burden placed on cannabis product producers and the public at the same time.

“This is where our AI technology can be of significant benefit to the medical cannabis sector,” said Peter Mills. “Unlike other software solutions our risk-based auditing and inspection technology uses advanced statistical algorithms to quantitatively assess and control regulatory non-compliance risks within specified limits, or risk appetite. The software’s unique AI technology automatically focuses a producer’s limited monitoring and control activities on those areas of its operation that represent its highest risk exposure, while in-built data analytics significantly reduce the amount of time and effort needed to collect, analyze and report risk levels internally and externally - by up to 80%.”

Jason Webb, Chief Executive Officer of GCAC Australia says, “Our Cannabis Compliance AI is going to be transformative technology for the industry as it grows. Not only will it help all participants from licensed producers to product producers monitor their regulatory requirements, it will save significant time and costs in regulation management, accelerate knowledge and facilitate unprecedented data sharing for the betterment of medical cannabis users.”
