On January 10, 2022, Henri Petit, President and CEO of the Company, indirectly through Gestion H. Petit Inc., a company under the control and direction of Henri Petit, settled \$492,739.56 of debt (the “Debt Settlement”), comprising of advances made to the Company and accrued and unpaid compensation, in exchange of the issuance of 724,617 Units.

Such Common Shares and Class B Multiple Voting Shares he owns represents respectively 21.33% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares and 22.17% of the issued and outstanding Class B Multiple Voting shares. If all the outstanding securities of the Company were exercised or converted into Common Shares, Henri Petit would own, directly or indirectly, 12,438,141 Common Shares, representing 9.88% of the Company’s then outstanding Common Shares, on a fully diluted basis.
