On December 21, 2021, 1279059 BC LTD. (“**BCCo**”), a company controlled by Emma Fairhurst agreed to purchase 1,200,000 shares in the capital of the Company in a private sale, to be transferred February 2, 2022 (the “**Private Sale**”).

On January 28, 2022, BCCo received 2,250,000 common shares in the capital of the Company (the “**Campaign Shares**”) pursuant to a share purchase agreement dated January 27, 2022 between the Company, 1281750 B.C. Ltd. and the shareholders of 1281750 B.C. Ltd., one of which was BCCo.

On February 1, 2022, Aeternum Asset Advisors Inc., a company controlled by Emma Fairhurst, received 420,000 common shares in the Company in satisfaction of a debt settlement by way of a debt conversion agreement dated January 31, 2022 between the Company and Aeternum Asset Advisors Inc. (the “**Debt Settlement**”).

On February 1, 2022, Ms. Fairhurst was granted 550,000 stock options of the Company exercisable into common shares at a price of \$0.15 per common share for a period of five (5) years from the date of issuance (the “**Option Grant**”).

On November 19, 2021, BCCo, a company controlled by Emma Fairhurst, agreed to purchase 1,000,000 common shares in the capital of the Company from a private sale, transferred on February 2, 2022 (the “**February 2022 Private Sale**”, together with the Private Sale, the Campaign Shares, the Option Grant and the Debt Settlement, the “**Acquisition**”).

Prior to the completion of the Acquisition, Ms. Emma Fairhurst, beneficially owned and controlled, directly or indirectly, 23,975,000 Common Shares, 6,025,000 Warrants and 200,000 Options representing 38.20% on an undiluted basis and 43.70% on a partially diluted basis. Following the completion of the Acquisition, Ms. Fairhurst beneficially owns and controls, directly or indirectly, an aggregate of 28,845,000 Common Shares, 6,025,000 Warrants and 750,000 Options, representing approximately 45.96% of the Company’s issued and outstanding Common Shares on an undiluted basis and 51.22% of the Company’s issued and outstanding on a partially diluted basis.

Depending on market conditions, general economic and industry conditions, the Company's business and financial condition and/or other relevant factors, Ms. Fairhurst may develop such plans or intentions in the future.
