On March 17, 2021, the Issuer issued additional Shares and the percentage of Shares controlled by the Acquiror fell below 10 percent of the issued and outstanding Shares of the Issuer.

As of March 17, 2021, the number of issued and outstanding Shares of the Issuer increased from 36,121,936 to 49,490,701 Shares on non-diluted basis and from 66,384,186 to and 75,995,951 Shares on fully diluted basis; therefore, 4,411,765 Shares controlled by the Acquiror represented 8.91% of the Shares on non-diluted basis and 5.81% of the Shares on fully diluted basis.
