4. Summary of Material Change

On April 24, 2019, the Company announced that it has closed the second tranche of the Company's non-brokered private placement (the "**Offering**") previously announced on April 15, 2019, of an additional CAD \$1,210,000 for a total of 1,210,000 units of the Company ("**Units**"), bringing total gross proceeds raised by the Offering to CAD \$5,510,000. Each Unit consists of a principal amount of unsecured promissory notes of the Company ("**Promissory Notes**") and common share purchase warrants of the Company ("**Warrants**").

5.1 Full Description of Material Change

On April 24, 2019, the Company announced that it has closed the second tranche of the Offering, of an additional CAD \$1,210,000 for a total of 1,210,000 Units, bringing total gross proceeds raised by the Offering to CAD \$5,510,000. Each Unit consists of a principal amount of Promissory Notes and Warrants.

As previously disclosed, proceeds of the Offering will be used to provide short term working capital for operations at the Company's extraction facility in California, purchase of additional biomass inventory, capital costs at the Sunniva California Campus and general corporate purposes.

The Units issued under the Offering were issued under the following terms:

Promissory Notes

• Maturity: The earlier of (i) two business days following receipt by the Company of proceeds from the sale of any or all of the Company's Canadian assets following the closing date, which, in the aggregate, are equal to or greater than the proceeds of the Offering; and (ii) 6 months from the closing date.

• Interest Rate: 10% (annual rate).

Warrants

- Number of Warrants: 0.1897 Warrants per Unit (each Warrant entitles the holder to acquire one common share of the Company at the Warrant Exercise Price).
- Warrant Exercise Price: CAD\$5.27 per Warrant.
- Warrant Term: 24 months from closing

A finder's fee of 5% payable in cash was paid to certain investment advisors for introducing certain purchasers of Units to the Company.

Resolutions of the board of directors were passed on April 9, 2019 and April 24, 2019, approving the Offering. No materially contrary view or abstention was expressed or made by any director in connection with the above resolutions, other than Dr. Anthony F. Holler, a director of the Company who abstained from the approval due to his interest in the Offering.
