On September 18, 2020, the Issuer completed the acquisition of 100% interest in Exploits Gold Corp., a private company focused on gold exploration in the Exploits subzone of Newfoundland and Labrador, for consideration of 18,910,752 common shares of the Issuer (the “**Common Shares**”) pursuant to a Share Exchange Agreement dated September 1, 2020. The Acquiror acquired ownership and control over 5,000,000 Common Shares at a deemed price of \$0.315 per Common Share for consideration of \$1,575,000 as proceeds from the sale of the Acquiror’s 5,000,000 common shares of Exploits Gold Corp.

2.3 State the name of any joint actors

John Michael William Collins (“**Collins**”), the President, Chief Executive Officer and a director of the Acquiror and the Issuer.

Volatus Capital Corp. (“**Volatus**”), a company of which Collins is the President, Chief Executive Officer and a director.

On September 18, 2020, the Issuer issued 18,910,752 Common Shares from treasury which diluted the Acquiror's securityholding percentage in the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer. The Acquiror acquired 5,000,000 Common Shares of the Issuer, which represents a decrease of 3.71% in the Acquiror's securityholding percentage in the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer, based on a total of 43,511,302 Common Shares outstanding as of September 18, 2020.

3.2 State whether the acquiror acquired or disposed ownership of, or acquired or ceased to have control over, the securities that triggered the requirement to file the report.

The Acquiror acquired ownership and control over the Common Shares that triggered the requirement to file this report.

Subsequent to the Transaction, the Acquiror owned and controlled 13,602,500 Common Shares of the Issuer representing 31.26% of the then issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer based on a total of 43,511,302 Common Shares outstanding as of September 18, 2020.

The Acquiror together with Collins and Volatus own and control 14,630,000 common shares of the Issuer representing 33.62% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Issuer based on a total of 43,511,302 Common Shares outstanding as of September 18, 2020.
