



## EXPLOITS ACQUIRES CLAIMS IN VICINITY OF RECENT HI-GRADE GOLD DISCOVERIES WITHIN CENTRAL NEWFOUNDLAND

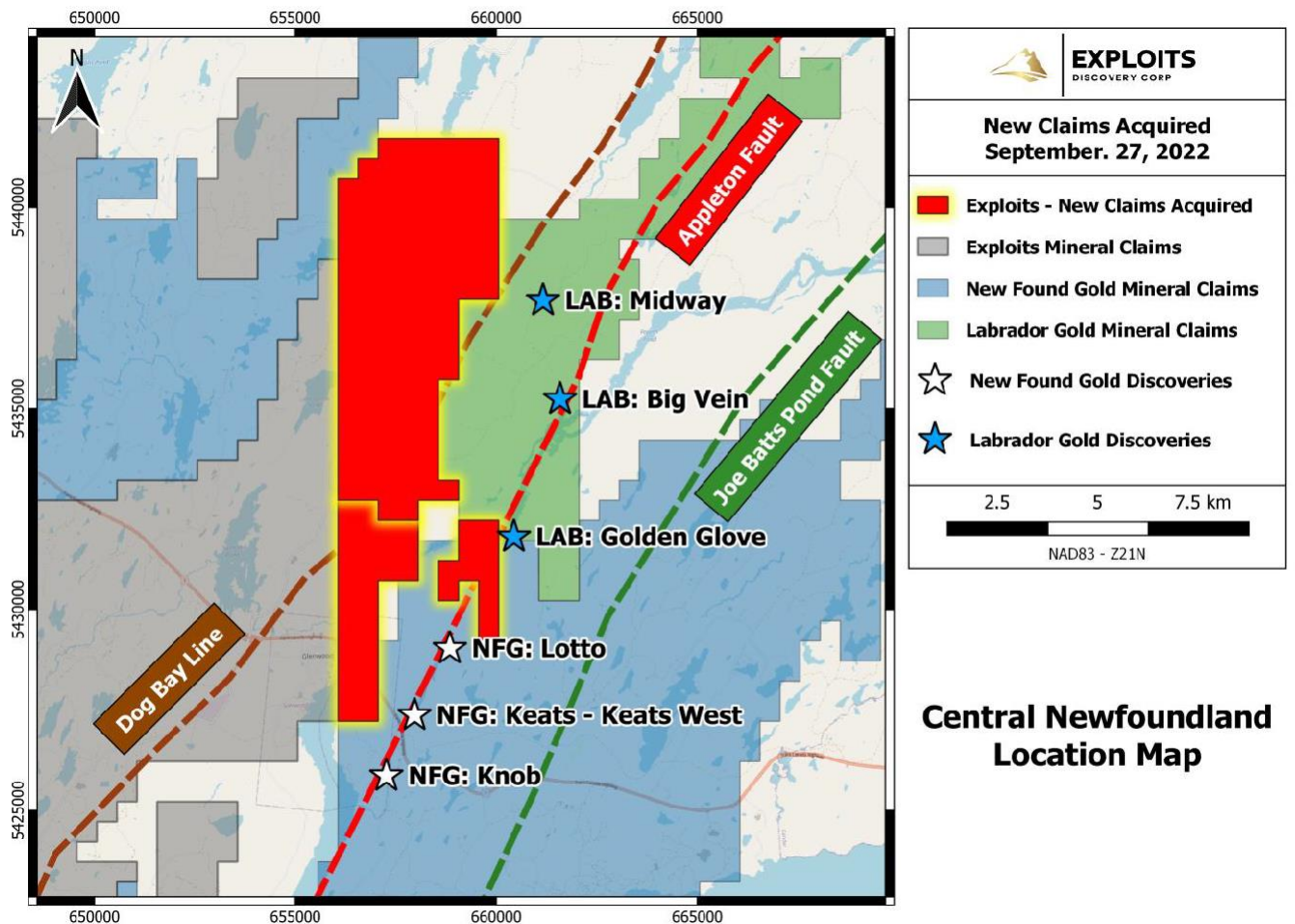


Figure 1: Overview map showing new claims acquired by Exploits.
