On November 11, 2020, the Acquiror completed a single open market purchase through the facilities of the Canadian Securities Exchange to acquire ownership and control over 2,865,000 Common Shares (the “**Acquired Shares**”) of Canbud Distribution Corporation (the “**Issuer**”), representing 7.48% of the issued and outstanding common shares (the “**Common Shares**”) of the Issuer (the “**Acquisition**”). The Acquired Shares were purchased at a price of \$0.04 per Acquired Share.

Pursuant to the Acquisition, the Acquiror acquired 2,865,000 Common Shares, representing approximately 7.48% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares on an undiluted basis. Prior to the Acquisition, the Acquiror held an aggregate of 8,400,000 Common Shares, representing 21.94% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares on an undiluted basis. Following the Acquisition, the Acquiror beneficially owns and controls, directly or indirectly, an aggregate of 11,265,000 Common Shares, representing approximately 29.42% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares on an undiluted basis.

The Acquiror acquired 2,865,000 Common Shares pursuant to the Acquisition. See item 2.2.

Following the Acquisition, the Acquiror now owns 11,265,000 Common Shares, representing approximately 29.42% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares on an undiluted basis. See item 3.1.
